Sport Admin Student Wins Athens Gold

Nick Taylor, an undergraduate student majoring in sport administration, won a Paralympic Wheelchair Tennis gold medal in the Quads doubles competition Sept. 26 in Athens, Greece. Taylor also advanced to the bronze medal match in singles competition.

"It is the greatest experience of my life! " Taylor said. "Probably I am heading to Beijing (in 2008) now.

Taylor was described by Games officials as a crowd favorite. His win marked the USA's first-ever gold medal at the tourney.
