

- Launch Faculty and Community Partner survey to assess stakeholder perceptions of student competencies gained.

- Explore campus partnership with FARE and WSU Connect to continue to support faculty development.
- Host a Round Table for Service-Learning for faculty development.
- Explore ARC presentation for Service-Learning faculty development.
- Connect with new faculty via New Faculty Orientation to share Service-Learning best practices and resources for community engaged scholarship.
- Explore addition of annual award for service-learning/ community engaged scholars as part of the annual faculty awards program.
