THE CENTRAL & WESTERN KANSAS CHAPTER serves 69 counties across the state

More than 54,500 Kansans are living with Alzheimer's or other dementia. and more than 89,000 of their family members and friends are providing them with **unpaid care** valued at more than \$1.9 billion per year.

By 2025, more than 62,000 Kansas residents are expected to be living with Alzheimer's.

In the past year, your support has helped families and individuals who are facing Alzheimer's or other dementia.

The Alzheimer's Association answered more than **355 calls** from the Central and Western Kansas service area through our 24/7 Helpline, a service provided at no cost.

116 support groups were held reaching 810 individuals facing Alzheimer's or another dementia.

Care consultations were provided to 79 families.

Our 30 unique education programs were attended by **2,917** people living with Alzheimer's, family caregivers, and health care professionals.

81% of our awareness presentations and 75% of our Common Core Programs and Support Groups were powered by volunteer delivery.

Our chapter is committed to diversity, equity, and inclusion. More than **500 lives** have been helped in the past year through our partnerships with community organizations.

The Kansas state legislature recently began a Kansas Respite for Alzheimer's and Dementia program. This program provides individual unpaid dementia caregivers up to \$1,000 per year, if they qualify. The Alzheimer's Association collaborated with Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services and Kansas Area Agencies on Aging on this program. These agencies are currently being trained and the respite application process is being implemented.

Thank you for your support of the Alzheimer's Association. We continue to provide critical programs and services to more and more families. We appreciate you.


