


The Fairmount College Student Advisory Council:

Fairmount College faculty teach: 33 percent of all Honors Seminars; 67 percent of all honors courses;








Fairmount College provides:

- 44 percent of all WSU online credit hours;
- 48 percent of all non-degree for-credit enrollments

Fairmout College faculty teach:

- 39 percent of all Badge courses;
- 53 percent of all Badge course enrollments;
- 49 percent of all credit hours in non-degree, for-credit courses
- Fairmount College saw a 54 percent increase in wholly online students from Fall 2016 to Fall 2017. One hundred-eighty one majors are now enrolled in online degree programs.



Fairmount College:

- Experienced 70 percent increase in research grants from Fiscal Year 2015 to Fiscal Year 2017;
- Procured \$4.79 million in grants in Fiscal Year
 2017:
- Procured more than \$10 million in grants to date in Fiscal Year 2018
- Recent successful grant applicants include George Bousfield, biological sciences, and Rui Ni, psychology.



Fairmount College is diverse:

- 236 LAS courses include diversity content;
- 32 percent of the 4,089 LAS enrollees are racial or ethnic minorities;
- 62 percent of LAS majors are female;
- 20 percent of LAS majors are 30 or older
