### Fact Sheet

The department offers two degrees—a Bachelor of Arts-Sport Management and a Master of Education-Sport Management.

Wichita State is one of only nine universities in the world whose sport management programs are accredited by the Commission on Sport Management Accreditation.

Wichita State is the only university in the U.S. west of the Mississippi River with COSMA-accredited sport management programs.

More than 130 undergraduate students and 60 graduate students are currently majoring in sport management at WSU.

WSU sport management alumni work in varied sport settings, including professional sport, college athletics, sport service providers, and the sporting goods industry. In major level pro sports, the department has placed interns or graduates with 13 NBA, 11 NFL, and 10 MLB franchises.

Wichita State has an active Sport Management Student Association that holds social, networking, and educational events throughout the year, including an annual sport management career fair.

Wichita State has an active Sport Management Alumni Association that annually provides scholarship support for students. It also held its first-ever sport management alumni reunion in April 2012.

Wichita State was one of just eight institutions accepted to compete in the 2012 Case Cup competition, held in conjunction with the 2012 National Sports Forum in Oklahoma City.

Sport management faculty are internationally recognized, having published and presented in dozens of academic and professional forums and worked in partnership with a range of sport organizations such as the NCAA and ESPN.
