HOW TO APPLY

1. Fill out the general application form on the scholarship Universe platform with students Grade level, GPA, Major, Etc.
2. Complete the FAFSA, if students cannot complete the FAFSA, they should submit an essay describing their need for financial aid in detail.
3. Students should write and submit a personal essay about academic careers and goals.
4. Students should include an activities chart showcasing extracurricular involvement
5. Students should answer as many matching questions as possible on the Scholarship Universe platform.

Scholarship Qualifications

Students are encouraged to maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and a score of 21 on the ACT or SAT score of 1060.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

1. Take the ACT/SAT and send official scores to Wichita State University (High School Students).
2. Apply for admission at wichita.edu/apply.
3. Submit \$40 application fee.
4. Submit official transcripts from all previous colleges (Transfer Students).
5. Apply for financial aid at Studentaid.gov when the FASFA opens in December.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

FRESHMAN STUDENTS

- Have a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.25 on a 4.0 scale, **OR**
- Achieve an ACT composite score of 21 or higher **OR** a minimum SAT (test optional for admission) composite score of 1080.
- **AND** if applicable, achieve a 2.0 GPA on all college credit taken in high school.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Achieve a 2.0 transfer cumulative GPA for general admission to Wichita State.
- Visit wichita.edu/transfergateway to see how your credits will transfer toward a Wichita State degree.

Freshman Merit & Academic Scholarships (Four-Year Awards)

Nov. 1 priority Consideration date.
Renewable scholarships based on merit and academics split over four years.

Transfer Merit Scholarships (Two-Year Awards)

Feb. 1 priority consideration date.
Renewable scholarships of \$2,000 or \$3,000 based on merit split over two years.
