RECENT SYNERGISTIC ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

1. In 2016, I proposed Master degree in Supply Chain Management at Barton School of Business in collaboration with the College of Engineering. Proposal accepted by the University and approved by Kansas Board of Regent in 2017. Acceptance of Applications for the master's degree program has started in Spring 2018. The program offers two tracks: Management and Business Analytics.
2. I and a colleague of mine from Industrial Engineering developed a company specific online supply chain certificate, funded by the state grant of about \$250,000.
3. I interacted with ISM-Wichita and discussed the opportunity of offering a supply management related course. \$25,000 fund is secured for this purpose over five years starting in 2016.
4. Interacting with local chapters for Project Management Institute and Supply Chain Council to create opportunities for student engagement and learning
5. Collaboration with Dr. Yildirim and Dr. Kilic, developed a global learning course on supply chain management at graduate level. Experience and lesson learned will be disseminated via a publication in education based journal
