



Professional and Scholarly Integrity Training (PSIT)

Instructions

Graduate School requires all graduate students to receive training in responsible conduct of research. To this end, College of Engineering requires graduate students to complete the following four modules of Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI):

1. Research misconduct
2. Publication practices and responsible authorship
3. Conflict of interest and commitment
4. Ethical issues in management of data

This is an online tool, free to use for all members of the Wichita State University (students, staff, and faculty members). The results will be communicated to the Office of Research Administration (ORA), which will inform the respective department when someone completes the training in one of the above modules. CITI training is provided in a modular form and only the above modules are acceptable for graduate students in the College of Engineering.

Proceed to www.wichita.edu/citi and follow the steps under “CITI Registration and Completion Instructions.” It is **very important** that you register and logon the CITI website “Through My Institution” with your *myWSU* ID to ensure that you are given the proper credit for completing the four modules. The four required modules listed above are included in the “Graduate Student Basic RCR” course as you can see and add when you proceed to Step 2: Add the required CITI modules.

You should complete the training requirements as soon as possible, preferably within the first year of your graduate studies.
