


Coach Newsletter September 27, 2025

This challenge will award winners in each of the 3 BEST Regions: Texas, Denver, and South. The prize is a *Prusa 3D Printer*!

If you do not have access to a 3D printer, we can help you find a solution. I know that some of our participating teams offered help in this area last year, and I am sure they would extend it this year. Also Wichita has a couple maker spaces, and WSU specifically has Innovation Project Hub that I believe will help.

Critical Design Reviews will be held Oct 8, 9, and 10. Time slots have been made available for sign-up on the Team Workflow. If you can't find one that fits your schedule, contact me, we might be able to do a one-off for you. Remember these ARE mandatory, but ARE NOT judged or scored. They are a coaching opportunity.

For teams choosing to participate in the BEST Award, sign-ups for the Marketing Presentation are also open. These will be online again this year (Zoom), and held on Oct 20 and 22. These presentations should be well planned, and practiced. You want to make sure your audience will be able to hear everyone speaking, and see any presentations or props you are using.
