Organization

A specific problem encountered when building or programming a robot is identified.					
The strategy used to approach the problem is clearly described.					
The team references the engineering design process to describe how the problem was addressed and solved.					
Team describes lessons learned from a setback or failure.

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Participation					
More than one student participates in the presentation.					
More than one student provides answers to questions.					
Students answer questions from the judges with specific information.					
The team membership is well-represented in the presentation room.

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Delivery					
Students speak clearly and loud enough for judges to hear.					
Students maintain eye contact and speak directly to judges or to the judge asking a question.					
Students use correct grammar and rarely use filler words.					
Students are poised and speak with confidence.

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Team Presentation Scoring

Points Possible: 500

Score multiplied by 6.25

Novice: $1 * 6.25 = 6.25$

Emerging: $2 * 6.25 = 12.5$

Proficient: $3 * 6.25 = 18.75$

Accomplished: $4 * 6.25 = 25$

Exemplary: $5 * 6.25 = 31.25$

Maximum points $31.25 * 16 = 500$

No team will score zero.

Minimum points possible $6.25 * 16 = 100$
