

Build Instructions for Fish Food Course Drawbridge Instructions:

- Cut the hardboard to 30" x 12" (drawbridge)
- Paint both sides of the drawbridge Navy Blue
- Position the drawbridge and mark the placement of hinges
- Pull the drawbridge off and sand the hinges and the back of the drawbridge where the hinges will be glued
- Use the epoxy to glue the hinges to the drawbridge
- Once the epoxy is dry, drill pilot holes into the base where the hinges will go
- Attach the hinges to the drawbridge using the provided screws
- Tape off the and paint the white line down the middle of the drawbridge
- Build the Finish Platform, making sure to place a 1/4" skin on one side and the top

Walls and Ships Instructions:

- Cut three 6" long 1x4's (pirate ships)
- Cut five 8" long 1x6's (fish/shark walls)
- Spray paint pirate ships Harbor Blue on all surfaces
- Spray paint the walls Cherry (red) on one side, Harbor Blue on the opposite, and the edges Navy Blue (painting the edges is optional), as shown in Figure 1
- Attach velcro to the back of the pirate ships (hinge side), as shown in Figure 2 (optional)
- Attach velcro to the Harbor Blue side (hinge side) of the walls, as shown in Figure 2 (optional)

Base Instructions:

- Paint the 1/2" x 4' x 8' plywood sheet Rustoleum Ultra Cover Latex Flat White Primer
- Paint the 1/2" x 4' x 8' plywood sheet Rustoleum Ultra Cover Latex Gloss Navy Blue
- Cut four 1x4's to 46 5/8" long (base supports)
- Using construction screws, frame the base, as shown in the course drawings.
- Paint the line and starting box as shown in the course drawings using the white paint
- Position and install the pirate ships, walls, and drawbridge using hinges, as shown in the course drawings.
- Position and install the walls, with the hinges on the Harbor Blue side, as shown in Figure 4.
