

Section V: Summary of the characteristics of degree recipients

1. **Description:** We used both the detailed analysis of Bachelor's Degrees Awarded in FY 2005 (hereafter called Analysis FY 2005) and the graduate profile conducted each semester. Analysis FY 2005 used official degree records and transcripts. The semi-annual graduate profile is done just prior to commencement using unofficial records and was designed primarily as a public relation tool. Nonetheless results are essentially the same between the two approaches.
2. **Profile of FY 2005 Graduates using official transcripts and degree records:**
 - a. Analysis FY 2005: N=1,825 students and time to degree
 - i. Median time to degree at WSU was 9 semesters. (4+ years) after first WSU enrollment. (Tables 7-8)
 - ii. Median number of semesters attended in the college awarding the degree was 9 semesters. (3+ years) (Tables 9-10)
 - iii. Almost a third of graduates had "stopped out" for one semester or more. (Chart 1)
 - b. Transfer Status FY 2005
 - i. 64% attended another school before attending WSU and transferred hours to WSU. (Chart 1)
 - ii. 15% did not transfer (N=271) any course work but only 14% (N=254) attended WSU exclusively. (Chart 1)
 - iii. A third of the credit hours used for these degrees were transferred from another institution. (Figure 3)
 - iv. Almost 41% started at WSU as freshmen, 14% as guests and 7% as seniors. (Figure 4 and Table 4)
 - c. Academic characteristics: Analysis FY 2005
 - i. 21% of graduates took a developmental math course but only 9.5% completed these courses at WSU (Figure 5)
 - ii. 14% of graduates took a developmental English course but only 8% completed these courses at WSU (Figure 5)
 - iii. Varying slightly by college, more than 60% of students earned their degree in the college of their original major. (Table 6)
 - d. Demographic Characteristics of Degree Recipients
 - i. 88% were Kansas Residents and almost 70% of these were from Sedgwick County. 6.4% were international students. (Table 3)
 - ii. 60% women (Figure 1)
 - iii. 76% white, 15% ethnic minority and 7% international (Figure 2)
3. **Unofficial Graduate Profile completed prior to commencement**
 - a. Based on first semester at WSU, the average time is slightly more than five years and median is 4 years. This figure includes all students regardless of transfer status.
 - b. Transfer status
 - i. 83-85% of recipients transferred 6 or more hours
 - ii. The average number of institutions attended including WSU is 2.8
 - c. Demographic graduate profile:
 - i. Average age is 27 years (median 24)
 - ii. 60% female and 18% minorities
 - iii. Graduates come from 20 or more states, and over 30 different countries

Subject: Analysis of Degrees Awarded in FY2005

Institutional Research has completed an analysis of the characteristics of people who received bachelor's degrees in FY2005 with particular attention to 'stop-outs' and transfers. A total of 1,851 degrees were awarded to 1,825 students. (Table 1)

The initial chart depicts graphically the path these 1,825 students followed in earning their degrees. More detailed information is available on this chart.

- Only 15% of the graduates enrolled exclusively at WSU.
- A third "stopped out" (i.e. did not enroll in consecutive semesters, excluding summers) following their initial WSU enrollment.
- Most students "stopped out" only one time.
- Median stop-out time was 3-6 semesters.
- Approximately 40% transferred all hours completed before their initial WSU enrollment.
- Another 40% completed transfer hours from other institutions even after their initial enrollment at WSU.

Other characteristics of the graduates are as follows:

- Liberal Arts and Business awarded almost 63% of the degrees and Education 15% (See Table 1)
- 60% were women and 24% were minorities or international students. (See Figures 1 and 2)
- About a third of all credit hours earned by these students were awarded by another institution. (Figure 3)
- 88% of graduates were Kansans and 69% were from Sedgwick County. (Table 3)
- 14% (N=257) of the students began their WSU career as a 'guest' with 93% of this group beginning as a high school guest or college guest. (See Table 4)
- Median age at initial enrollment was 20 years. (Table 5)
- The majority of students earn their degree in the college in which they originally enrolled. (See Table 6)
- 21% completed a developmental mathematics course at WSU or another school. 14% did so in English. (Figures 5 and 6)
- Median time to degree is 7 semesters (3 years) in their major (See Tables 7 and 8)
- Median time to degree is 9 semesters (4 years) at WSU (See Tables 9 and 10)

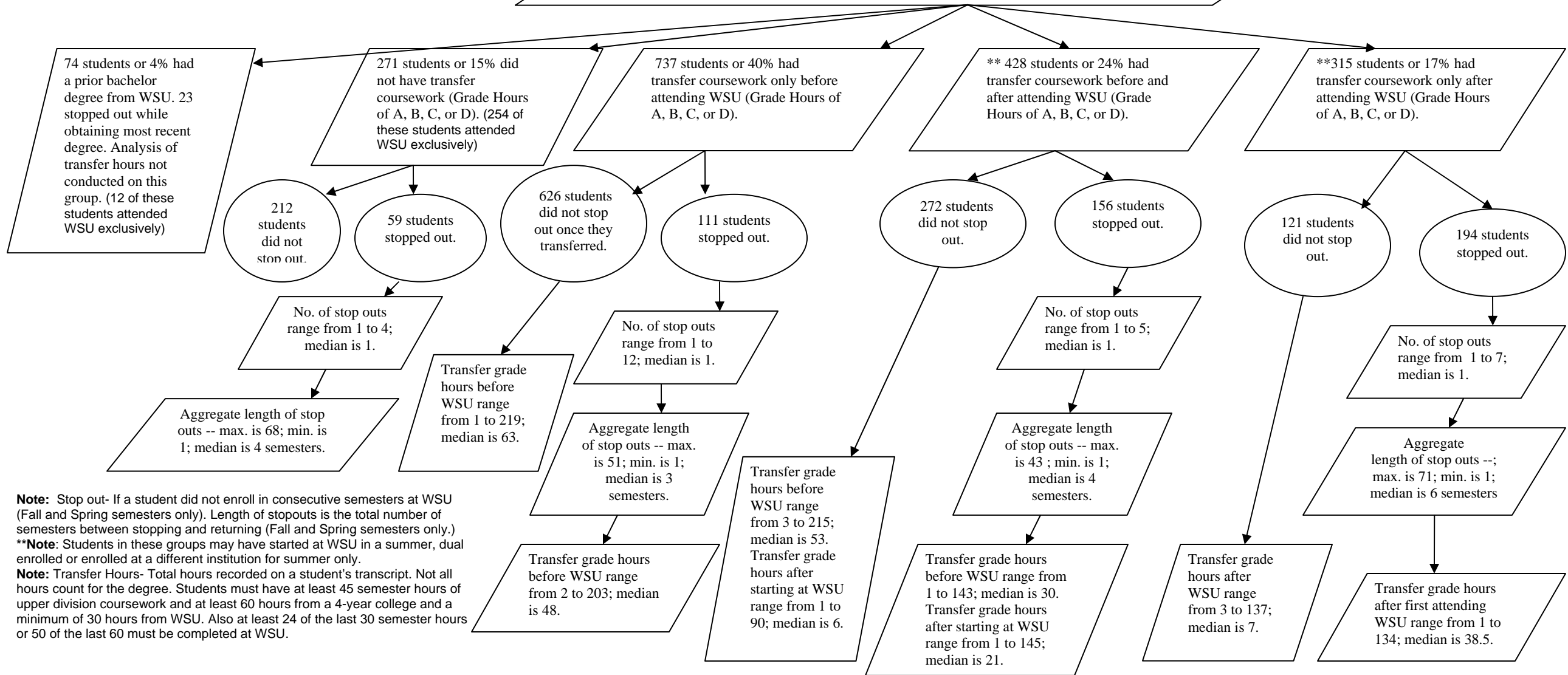

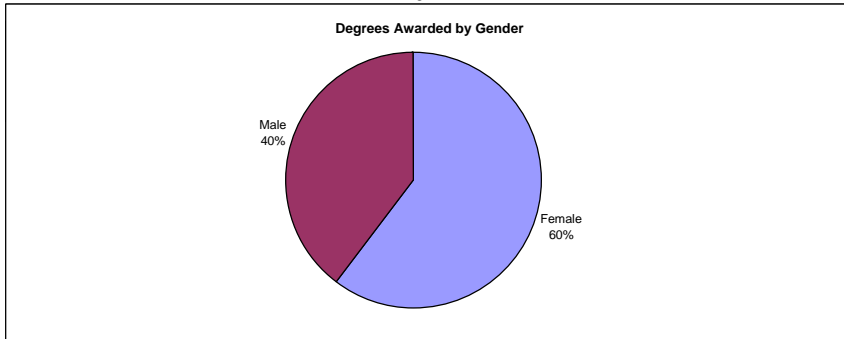

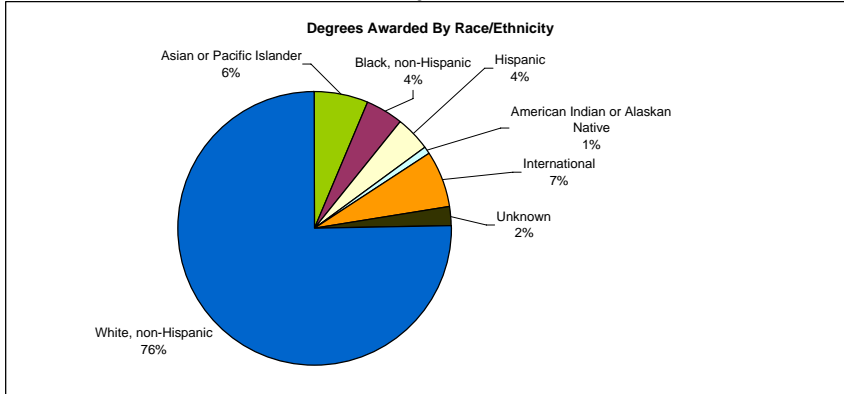

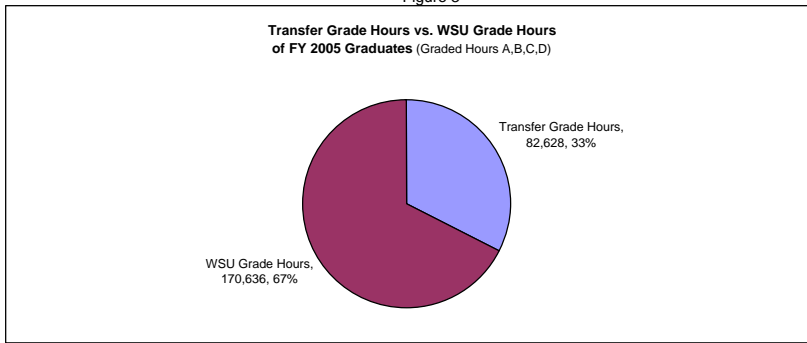

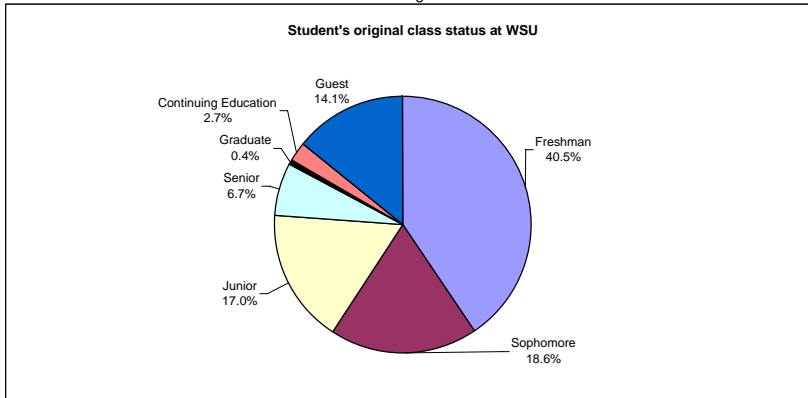

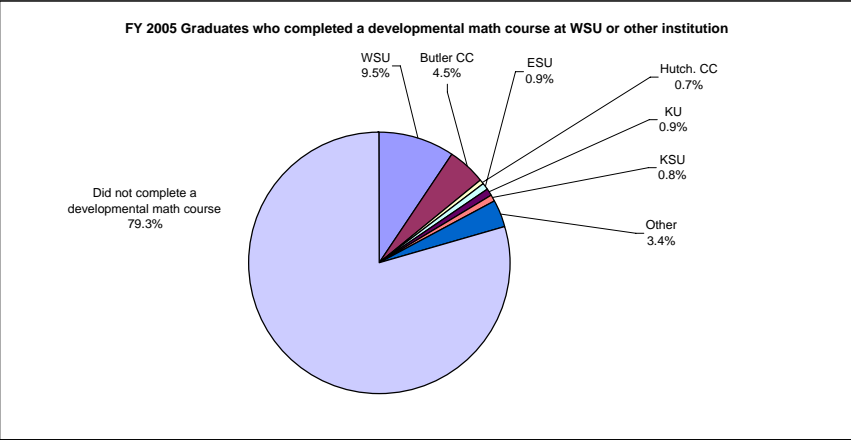
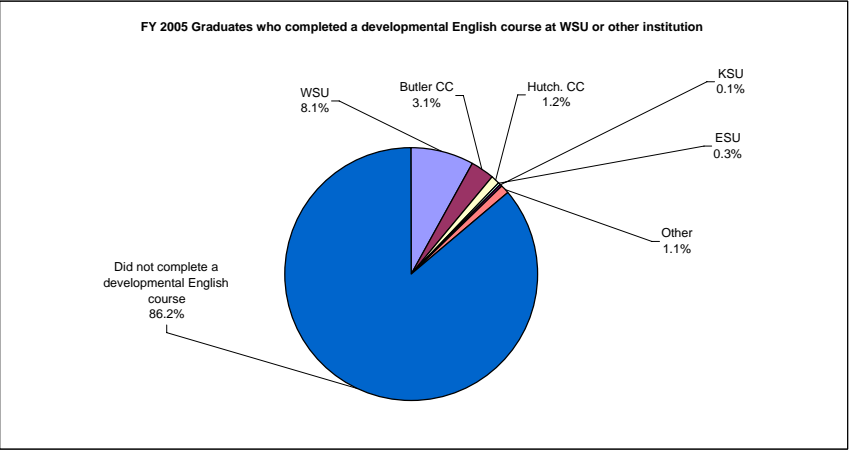
