President's Report	 Covid FAQs and update University has not imminent plans to move online. Faculty may make a temporary change of delivery method in consultation with chair and dean. KBOR Update Optional one-year extension to the tenure calendar is granted for tenure-track faculty hired in 2020, now including Fall 2020 hires. This does also include those faculty who were hired with years credited. KBOR is creating a steering committee for the program review process at the KBOR level. This will likely not impact WSU. Governor Kelly's Proposed Budget Questions were raised as to whether faculty were considered state employees. President Bailey is going to be asking General Counsel. A question was also raised about the market-based compensation, and HR's Scott Hankins will follow up with the market-based compensation team and share with the Senate. AVP / Provost Search Process will be done in three pools. First pool of applicants is being considered. Smaller pool sizes allows the committee to give more focus on the candidates.
