Directions:

- First, answer the five questions found below.
- Next, find the gravestones of these five people (the answers to the five questions). Refer to the linked map for assistance.
- Then, find the flowers at each gravestone; these flowers have letters (on the back). Please **do not** take the flowers with you! Simply record the letter you have found corresponding with each gravestone flower. While recording the letters, remember to please stick with **one color (blue or red)** throughout the scavenger hunt.
- After you have collected all five letters, unscramble the letters to figure out the secret word. (**HINT**: it is related to cemeteries)

Each of the five questions tie into Maple Grove Cemetery and Wichita State University.

***NOTE**: If you are the competitive type and choose to compete with others, split into 2 groups (blue flower team and red flower team). If you choose to participate solo, that is fine too!

1. Who was the 1st President of Fairmount College (WSU)? Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave. *****Don't forget to take a selfie with the headstone of Fairmount College's first president and wife. A selfie must be submitted with your drawing entry to be eligible for the prizes.*****

2. Who was the 1st Dean of Fairmount College (WSU)? Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.

3. This individual was one of the Deans of Fairmount College (WSU). Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.

4. Who was the professor and head of the Art Department (WSU)? Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.

5. This individual has a building named after them and was the Dean of Women, Fairmount College (WSU). Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.
