- First, answer the five questions found below.
- Next, find the gravestones of these five people (the answers to the five questions). Refer to the linked map for assistance.
- Then, find the flowers at each gravestone; these flowers have letters (on the back). Please <u>do not</u> take the flowers with you! Simply record the letter you have found corresponding with each gravestone flower. While recording the letters, remember to please stick with <u>one color (blue or red)</u> throughout the scavenger hunt.
- After you have collected all five letters, unscramble the letters to figure out the secret word. (**HINT**: it is related to cemeteries)

Each of the five questions tie into Maple Grove Cemetery and Wichita State University. ***NOTE**: If you are the competitive type and choose to compete with others, split into 2 groups (blue flower team and red flower team). If you choose to participate solo, that is fine too!

- 4. Who was the professor and head of the Art Department (WSU)? Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.
- 5. This individual has a building named after them and was the Dean of Women, Fairmount College (WSU). Write the name and birth and death years found on the grave.
