1. Four (4) scholarships will be awarded annually to undergraduate students enrolled full time at Wichita State University in the Spanish program in the Department of Modern and Classical Languages and Literature of the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, marital status, political affiliation, status as a veteran, genetic information or disability.
3. Students must be pursuing an undergraduate education in Spanish language, literature, and/or education.
4. Recipients must have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and demonstrated work in Latino culture or promotion of cultural understanding.
5. Awards will be made without regard to financial need.
6. The donor's preference would be that a scholarship is awarded to a freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior each year, if possible.
7. If a student should become ineligible for the scholarship, a student of the same academic year standing and meeting all other guideline requirements, should be awarded the scholarship in their place.
8. The total amount available for awarding should be divided equally among the four (4) students.
9. Awards will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters.
10. The Scholarship Office of Wichita State University will administer the scholarships and make the awards based on the recommendations submitted by the Department of Modern and Classical Languages and Literature.
11. The scholarships may be renewable for a term of four (4) consecutive academic years as long as the recipients remain eligible.
