

Licensure

In accordance with Kansas law, graduates must sit for the licensure exam to practice social work and to be able to call themselves "social workers." MSW graduates can take the LMSW exam during their last semester or after graduation. MSW graduates can also become eligible to sit for the LSCSW exam.
