WSU VISTA Opportunities – Apply today, positions begin soon.

AmeriCorps VISTA members are passionate and committed to their mission to bring individuals and communities out of poverty. Members make a year-long, full-time commitment to serve on a specific project at a nonprofit organization and earn a modest **living allowance of \$22,800**. After a successful year of service, members are eligible for an **education award of \$6,895** or a post-service stipend. Current and past members are also eligible to apply for a \$2,000 WSU scholarship and other support. More information is available at www.americorps.gov. VISTA members must be **18 years old**, a **US Citizen or Permanent Resident** and have a limited criminal history.

Short-term, Part-time AmeriCorps Positions Be the Greater Good

WSU AmeriCorps Opportunities – Immediate Openings

AmeriCorps is your moment to take the path less traveled, to break the status quo, to stop talking about the problem and be the solution. Join AmeriCorps and you can mentor and tutor kids, rebuild a community after disaster, help veterans, or work with local communities to alleviate poverty. WSU AmeriCorps members serve part time for a set number of months at education-focused programs around the city. They receive a modest stipend and become eligible for an education award after successful service. AmeriCorps members must be 18 years old, a US Citizen or Permanent Resident and have a limited criminal history. Members are eligible to apply for a \$2,000 WSU scholarship.

Family Learning

Public Broadcasting Station (PBS) is looking for someone to create and execute STEAM educational programming geared for families with children ages 2-10 years.
