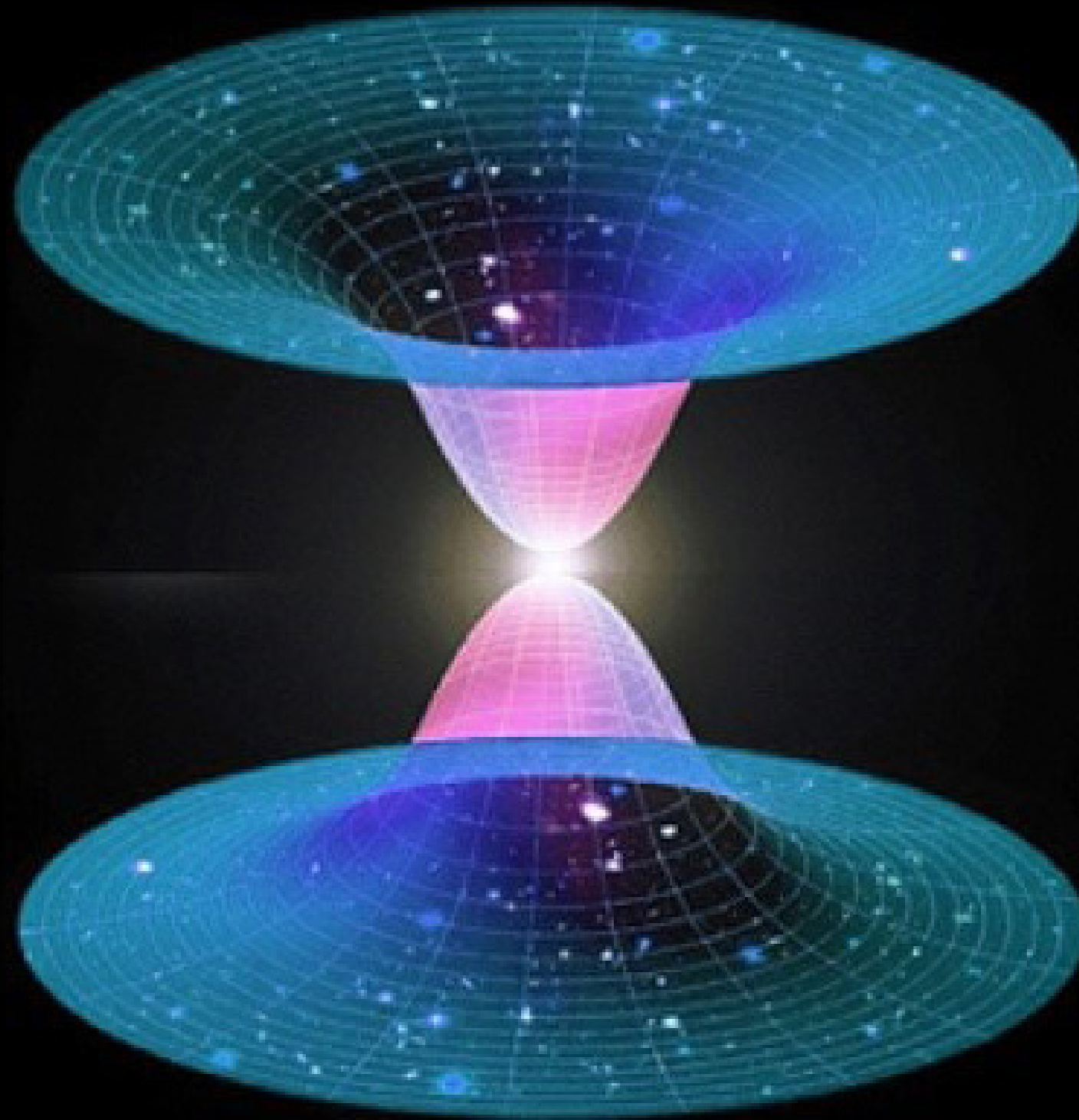

Carlo Rovelli is the director of the Theory Institute of Aix-Marseille University in France. He is a quantum gravity theoretical physicist with more than 200 science publications and creator of the loop quantum gravity idea. He is author of four popular science books including “Reality is not what it Seems,” a best seller translated into 41 languages. He continues to do research in quantum gravity and write popularizations for science, with a new book published in 2021, “Helgoland” by Penguin Random House press.
