1. Scholarships/fellowships will be awarded annually to one or more undergraduate or graduate students enrolled full-time at Wichita State University in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences Department of Mathematics, Statics, and Physics.
2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, political affiliation, status as a veteran, genetic information or disability.
3. Undergraduate scholarship support is restricted to mathematics majors or, in exceptional cases, undeclared students in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
4. Graduate fellowship support is restricted to students enrolled in a graduate degree program in mathematics or applied mathematics.
5. Recipient(s) must have and maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
6. Award will be made without regard to financial need.
7. The Scholarship Office of Wichita State University will administer the scholarship and/or the fellowship and make the award based on the recommendation(s) submitted by the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Mathematics, Statistics and Physics Department.
8. The award(s) may not be automatically renewed, but the current recipient(s) may re-apply.
