- 1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually to a student(s) enrolled full or part time at Wichita State University in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Department of Modern and Classical Languages and Literature.
- 2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a Vietnam Era Veteran or disability.
- 3. Consideration will be given to the depth of seriousness of the student relating to career goals and a demonstrated ability to profit from such experiences.
- 4. Award(s) will be made with regard to financial need.
- 5. The amount available for awarding each year shall be divided equally between #6 and #7.
- 6. SPANISH preference to Spanish major preparing to teach Spanish to be used to attend the WSU summer program in Puebla, Mexico, OR to help pay tuition during the student teaching semester.
- 7. FRENCH or GERMAN student interested in developing a major in either language; to be used to attend the WSU summer program in Strassbourg, France.
- 8. The Scholarship Office, a department within the Division of Student Affairs of Wichita State University, will administer the scholarship(s) and make the award. Recommendations submitted by a major professor or professors of that particular language will be given priority consideration.
- 9. The scholarship(s) may not be renewed.
