



Artistic Director: Elaine Quilichini

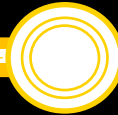
Internationally recognized choral conductor Elaine Quilichini has conducted across Canada, the United States, Australia, Japan, Argentina, and the Canary Islands.

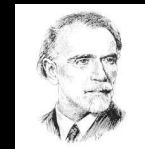

In this one-week camp, talented young singers have the opportunity to improve their vocal skills, spend time in campus recreation activities, and meet other student musicians. They will learn quality choral music and perform an exciting final concert on Friday evening.

Daily Activities:

Camp begins on Sunday afternoon, **June 3** and concludes with a concert on Friday, **June 8**. Students will be involved in choral rehearsals, musicianship and enrichment opportunities, as well as daily supervised recreation. Resident campers have special evening events and fun will be emphasized all week long!

Eligibility:

Students ages 10-17 with an unchanged singing voice and their music teacher's recommendation. **Camp is growing, spaces are limited. Enroll early.**

Package Cost for day campers by May 1.

\$230 (tuition, camp T-shirt, afternoon recreation, 2 snacks). **\$270** with lunch provided, A la carte evening activities available for additional costs.

Cost for resident campers by May 1:

\$600 (Includes tuition, housing at Shocker Hall, camp T-shirt, afternoon and evening recreation, all meals and 2 snacks.)

*Resident campers are housed Sunday night through Thursday night in air-conditioned WSU Shocker Hall with qualified in-house counselors. Single rooms can be reserved for an additional cost. Meals begin with Sunday dinner and end with Friday lunch. **Transportation to and from WSU is not included.***

How to apply:

1. Complete paper application. Send with \$50 non-refundable deposit (checks payable to WSU Fine Arts Institute). Mail to College of Fine Arts Institute, 3805 East Harry, 67218.

Registrations and final payment will be accepted until the limit is reached or until **Thursday, May 30, 2018**. Students will be notified of acceptance upon receipt of registration.
