#### Harp & Organ Majors

#### **Winds & Percussion Majors**

7 semesters of Symphonic Band (MUSP213B/413B) or Wind Ensemble (MUSP210B/410B). Plus one semester of an ensemble focusing on another musical genre (jazz, orchestra, choir, chamber, etc.)

#### **String Majors**

7 semesters of Symphony Orchestra (MUSP 211A/411A). Plus one semester of an ensemble focusing on another musical genre (jazz, orchestra, choir, chamber, etc.)

#### **Electric Bass Majors**

7 semesters of appropriate large ensemble (MUSP 211M/411M/ 211T/212T/411T/412T). Plus one semester of an ensemble focusing on another musical genre (jazz, orchestra, choir, chamber, etc.)

#### **Piano Majors**

4 semesters of Orchestra (MUSP 211A/411A), Symphonic Band (MUSP 213B/413B), Wind Ensemble (MUSP 210B/410B) or 4 semesters of Shocker Choir (MUSP 211D/411D) Wu Choir (MUSP 212D/412D), Concert Chorale (MUSP 213F/413F) plus 4 additional semesters of Piano Accompanying (MUSP 211J/411J).

#### **Transfer Students**

8 different semesters of Symphonic Band (MUSP 213B/413B) or Wind Ensemble (MUSP 210B/410B) or Orchestra (MUSP 211A/411A) including 4 different semesters of WSU Wind Ensemble (MUSP 410B) or Symphonic Band (MUSP 413B).
