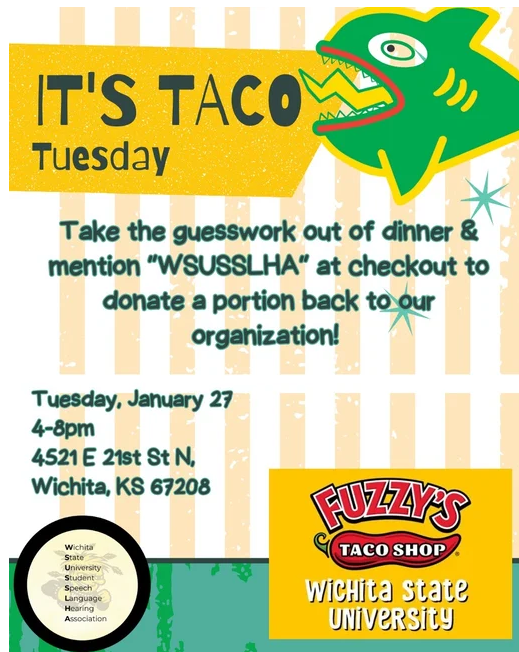


Kansas Legislative Day
