Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Degree Completion Program **Curriculum**

Students must be graduates of an accredited Dental Hygiene Program and licensed to practice dental hygiene to be eligible to enter the BSDH degree completion program. The bachelor's degree completion program (BSDH) at Wichita State University consists of the associate degree dental hygiene courses, the University's General Education requirements, and 32 BSDH credit hours. These 32 credit hours consist of 9 required courses and 2 electives.
