

Advance from Business Administration to Health Management

An Associate's degree in Business Administration provides a strong foundation for earning a Bachelor of Science in Health Management (BSHM) at Wichita State University. This degree combines business fundamentals with healthcare-specific knowledge, preparing graduates for leadership roles in hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare organizations.

Healthcare is one of the fastest-growing industries, with medical and health services manager roles projected to grow 29% from 2023 to 2033, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS). Wichita State's 100% Online BSHM program develops skills in finance and management while addressing healthcare challenges, preparing students for high-demand careers or advanced studies in healthcare operations and public health.

Students can also pursue the Accelerated Bachelor's to Master's in Health Administration (MHA), gaining leadership training and networking opportunities. With a median annual wage of \$110,680, the field offers strong career advancement prospects (BLS).
