Cohen Honors College Diversity Plan

- Changes to the Admissions criteria for the Honors College to be considered
- University of Oregon model no GPA/ACT requirement
- Proposal to change the by-laws to remove minimum GPA/ACT requirement to a more holistic application process. To consider resumes, letters of recommendation, volunteer work.
- 400 applications are considered each year. There has been an increase in applications and acceptance in the Hispanic student population recently. The Honors College is closer to the same percentage as the general student population.
- There are no students on the admissions committee, but there are students on the scholarship committees.
- Next steps: Meet with the Wonder School; look at the University of Chicago and Creighton Med School grading.

First Year Honors Student Experience

- New Student Retreat and Orientation (HCSC/FHAB)
