Airport Pick-Up Service	Free pick-up service is provided through the Office of International Education for when you arrive to Wichita(ICT). Students should ask for this service at least two weeks prior to their arrival date. More information will be emailed to you. However, for departure at the end of the semester, all students must find their own transportation to the airport at their own expense.
Health Insurance	Students will automatically be charged for health insurance unless they show proof of insurance that is EQUAL to that required by Wichita State University (and mandated by the federal government) and complete a waiver form online that has been approved by WSU. http://wichita.edu/medicalinsurance



Housing Covered Under Our Exchange Agreement	Accommodations on campus: 1. The Flats (apartments) 2. The Suites (residence hall) 3. Shocker Hall (residence hall) http://www.wichita.edu/housing *Generally, exchange students will live in The Flats, based on age and availability. Check with the Housing Office for more details about staying in a particular accommodation. Single private rooms are very limited in the residence halls and are generally not available. Exchange students are recommended to live on-campus, just as all first year students at WSU. If you wish to live off-campus, please email us for more information on this process (please note that we do not provide off-campus housing recommendations).
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Application Deadline for Housing & Meal Plans

Fall Semester	Students should complete the online application once admitted to WSU through MyWSU account online. If students are coming for fall semester only, then they will still need to complete the academic year housing application. The WSU International Education Office will provide a list of those students to the Housing Office so that they can cancel the second semester (spring). Apply online with MyWSU I.D.
Spring Semester	Students should complete the online application once admitted to WSU through MyWSU account online. Apply online with MyWSU I.D.

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Move-in Dates & Dining Hall Dates of Operation	Fall Semester: Exchange students may be required to arrive prior to the official move-in date for housing in order to attend the mandatory orientation. Given this, they will need to plan for a few extra days for housing fees and should contact the WSU Housing Office for specific costs. Please see the housing contract for the official move-in/move-out dates and check the pre-departure information for the arrival date for exchange students. 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Spring Semester: Exchange students may be required to arrive prior to the official move-in date for housing in order to attend the mandatory orientation. Given this, they will need to plan for a few extra days for housing fees and should contact the WSU Housing Office for specific costs. Please see the housing contract for the official move-in/move-out dates and check the pre-departure information for the arrival date for exchange students.

Students who wish to stay in the residence hall through spring break may be required to pay additional housing fees. Please contact the WSU Housing Office for specific costs and more information.

Dining services will be closed during Spring Break in March.

Full Academic Year: *Exchange students who will stay for both fall and spring semesters will be able to continue living in on-campus housing during the break for an extra fee.
