All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University in USD.
As of 08/07/2024, 1 Chilean Peso (CLP) = 0.0011 (USD)
- The university estimated that accommodations at the student residence will be about \$500 a month.
- The university estimated that meals are around \$250 USD per month.
- A transportation estimate was provided by the university at \$50 a month.
- The university estimated that books will cost about \$100.
- The GeoBlue Student Insurance Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. As of July 2024, it cost \$1.46 per day for a maximum \$100,000 coverage and \$100 deductible. 150 days (5 months) will be approximately \$219. There are different coverage plans available at different prices.
- Students studying in Chile for 1 semester (less than 180 days) must obtain a Permiso de Permanencia Transitoria (Temporary Stay Permit). The original Permiso de Permanencia Transitoria is only valid for 90 days and is free, but must be extended for another 90 days for \$100 while you are in Chile. Students who study in Chile for a full academic year will need to obtain a student visa for around \$200.
- Airfare cost was provided according to Orbitz as of July 2024 with travel dates of January 6, 2025 – June 2, 2025. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

* Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements.

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. In order to apply for visas, students may be required to show proof of funds, such as bank statements, to live in a host country. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
