- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.  
As of 06/27/20, 1 Euro (EUR) = 1.12 (USD)
- Hamburg Semester Contribution of 325 Euros must be paid by all students and includes a semester ticket which allows you unlimited travel on Hamburg's public transport system for the whole semester.
- Accommodations can range from 300-600 Euros per month.
- Meals are budgeted at approximately 335 Euros per month.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The LewerMark Student Insurance Silver Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. Currently, it costs \$1.10 per day plus \$10 administrative fee so 150 days will be \$175.
- It is required to get German Health Insurance for students while in Germany. This cost is approximately 95 Euros per month.
- Residence permit and alien registration are required for all non EU nationals staying in Germany longer than 90 days. Visas are obtained in Germany for about €75.
- Airfare cost was provided as an average (Orbitz, STA travel, Expedia) with travel dates of January 20, 2021- June 6, 2021. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

**\*Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements such as the business & engineering fees.**

**Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. In order to apply for visas, students may be required to show proof of funds, such as bank statements, to live in a host country. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.**
