## **Required Associated Fees**

- All above expenses are dependent on ISEP Exchange program. Student pays fees based on Wichita
  State University cost of living and tuition. This covers tuition, fees, housing, unlimited meal plan per
  week, pre-departure orientation, arrival orientation, and general student services at the host
  institution.
- ISEP Exchange Application Fee is \$100. ISEP placement fee of \$325.
- ISEP Health Insurance is required for all ISEP programs. This includes global emergency coverage and is approximately \$86 per month.
- Financial aid and scholarships usually applies for US students.
