**NOTES:** All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.  
As of 06/27/20 Swedish Krona (SEK) = 0.12 (USD)
- An obligatory student union fee is 330 SEK per semester.
- Accommodation expenses given by the university range from 3,000 to 6,500 SEK per month.
- Meals are calculated at 2,000 SEK per month.
- Local transportation is around 480 SEK per month. This accounts for a monthly bus ticket.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The LewerMark Student Insurance Silver Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. Currently, it costs \$1.10 per day plus \$10 administrative fee so 150 days will be \$175.
- JIBS provides Swedish health insurance at no cost.
- Studying in Sweden for more than three months, will require a visitor's permit. The visa application fee is \$121.00 as converted from 1,000 Swedish Kronas. Students must also show proof of funds to apply for the visa.
- Airfare cost was provided as an average (Orbitz, STA travel, Expedia) with travel dates of January 20, 2021 – June 6, 2021. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

**\* Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements such as the business & engineering fees.**

**Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. Often times, students will need to show proof of funds to live in the host country by means of bank statements in order to apply for visas. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.**
