NOTES: All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.
As of 06/27/20, 1 Mexican Peso (MXN) = 0.046 (USD)
- Accommodations in the residence halls are 32,500 pesos per semester.
- Meals are suggested around 15,000 pesos per semester.
- Cost of local transportation can vary. University provides a free shuttle service for students on campus. By metro/bus calculated at approx \$1 a day.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- There is a required fee of \$395 for health insurance from the university.
- A U.S. student enrolling for six months or less to study will pay a fee of \$36 for a visa.
- Airfare cost was provided as an average (Orbitz, STA travel, Expedia) with travel dates of January 20, 2021 – June 6, 2021. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

*These costs are an estimate based on the campus in Mexico City. Other campuses may vary in terms of costs of living.

***Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements such as the business & engineering fees.**

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. In order to apply for visas, students may be required to show proof of funds, such as bank statements, to live in a host country. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
