- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars a floating exchange rate.
As of 06/27/20, 1 Euro (EUR) = 1.12 (USD)
- A Compulsory Student Union fee is approximately 20 Euros per semester.
- Accommodation is given at 310 Euros per month plus the room and key deposits. There will be a refundable room deposit of 400 Euros and a refundable room key deposit of 100 Euros on arrival which are included in the accommodations estimate. Additionally, students will pay a cleaning fee of 70 Euros upon move-out.
- Meals are calculated for around 235 Euros per month.
- Local Transportation is free during the semester for a university shuttle bus to the city.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The LewerMark Student Insurance Silver Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. Currently, it costs \$1.10 per day plus \$10 administrative fee so 150 days will be \$175.
- All students going to Austria for one semester need to obtain the Austrian National Visa D. This is a fee of 171 USD.
- Airfare cost was provided as an average (Orbitz, STA travel, Expedia) with travel dates of January 20, 2021 – June 6, 2021. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

*** Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements such as the business & engineering fees.**

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. In order to apply for visas, students may be required to show proof of funds, such as bank statements, to live in a host country. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
