NOTES: All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate. As of 07/19/22, 1 British Pound (GBP) = 1.199 (USD)
- Accommodations at Chester University average 2,369.83 GBP per semester. Calculated as an average, this may vary depending on style, type of accommodation, and if it is on or off campus.
- University meal plans are between 235 and 450GBP per month, depending on if it covers daily lunch, dinner, or both. Costs may vary, as some residences will provide catering included in the rent.
- A monthly bus ticket in Chester is 38 GBP.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The LewerMark Student Insurance Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. As of July 2022, it cost \$1.16 per day for a maximum \$100,000 coverage and \$100 deductible. 152 days (5 months) will be approximately \$180. There are different coverage plans available at different prices.
- There is no visa fee for US students going for one semester.
- Airfare cost was provided according to Orbitz as of July 2022 with travel dates of January 12, 2023 – June 8, 2023. We calculated the cost of a ticket to the Birmingham Airport, then added a bus ticket cost at approximately \$114. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

*** Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements.**

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. Often times, students will need to show proof of funds to live in the host country by means of bank statements in order to apply for visas. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
