All fees are based on a 5 month period for a fall or spring semester.

- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.
As of 06/27/20, 1 British Pound (GBP) = 1.31 (USD)
- Accommodations at Chester University average 350 GBP per month. Calculated as an average, this may vary depending on style and type of accommodation.
- Optional meal plans are offered by the dining hall at Chester for all students and is operated 5 days a week. Meals are calculated at about 180 GBP per month.
- Local Transportation is most likely not needed. Chester is easily accessible by foot; however, there are public buses if needed. 200 GBP has been added to the budget for the cost of transportation. A monthly bus pass is 40 GBP per month.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The LewerMark Student Insurance Silver Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. Currently, it costs \$1.10 per day plus \$10 administrative fee so 150 days will be \$175.
- U.S. students are exempt from visa fees unless they plan to find employment or stay longer than 6 months.
- Airfare cost was provided as an average (Orbitz, STA travel, Expedia) with travel dates of January 20, 2021 – June 6, 2021. This should provide a good estimate to cover the airfare expense.
- Personal expense estimates are provided by Financial Aid for students living on the WSU campus, which will be similar during a study abroad program.

*** Tuition and Fees are based on the Resident rate for 12 undergraduate credit hours at Wichita State University. Students will pay their current tuition rate during the study abroad program based on their residency and any specific college/department requirements such as the business & engineering fees.**

Disclaimer: All costs are estimates and subject to change. Some universities will require payment for accommodations in advance as well as other fees. Often times, students will need to show proof of funds to live in the host country by means of bank statements in order to apply for visas. Please note extra travel expenses are not included. Budget accordingly.
