The AIFS/Wichita State program fees include the following:

Accommodation & Meals

- Twin or triple-bedded rooms in a hotel including linens, towels, & Wi-Fi

- 1. All students must submit the \$450 enrollment deposit when completing the online enrollment form. Subsequent payments may be made by check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to "AIFS." American Express, MasterCard, and Visa are accepted.
- 2. Students using financial aid are responsible for paying, by March 25, 2025, an \$850 program reservation deposit and any remaining balance that will not be covered by aid.

3. Please note: A \$35 returned check fee will be charged on all checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

Refund policy and important dates to remember should you need to cancel your participation:

Withdrawing on or before Friday, February 21, 2025	All fees paid less than a \$150 processing fee will be refunded.
Withdrawing after Friday, February 21, 2025 and on or before Tuesday, March 25, 2025	All fees paid less the \$450 deposit and any non-refundable deposits paid by the participant or by AIFS on the participant's behalf will be refunded.
Withdrawing after Tuesday, March 25, 2025	No refund and the total program fee is due.

Please note that after the final payment deadline the full program fee is due to AIFS even if you have not yet paid and do not participate or plan to participate in the program. Non-refundable financial commitments have been made to secure your spot. If a participant withdraws once the program has begun, there is no refund. This refund policy applies whether a participant pays AIFS Abroad directly for all, part, or no program fees.

Protecting your investment:

Participants will have the option of purchasing additional trip cancellation or interruption insurance which allows them to protect their study abroad program. This policy includes options to cancel for any reason (CFAR) and interrupt for any reason (IFAR). Details of the Worldwide Trip Protector Plans with travel insurance underwritten by the United States Fire Insurance Company, rated A (Excellent) by A.M.
