NOTICE: Per the Kansas Board of Regents Policy, Kansas residents 60 years of age and older can enroll as auditors in academic credit courses when space is available without paying tuition. The only cost to these students is any applicable workshop fees and lab/special course fees. All course fees will be scholarshiped by Wichita State University provided that the student is 60+ years of age, is a Kansas resident and registers before February 24, 2021. Senior citizens must present a Medicare card or driver's license to validate age. Students who are younger than 60 years of age can enroll in the course but will pay regular tuition and fees (please call 316-978-3731 for more information).
