## Updates

- COVID-19 Response Survey
  - The survey is out with 783 responses to date. It is expected to close on Monday/Tuesday of next week. The option to keep the link live is available, if the effort to gain more responses is desired.
  - Next steps
    - Look at responses around the need for telehealth pre- and post-COVID.
    - Review the overall university responses and then disaggregate by colleges.
- University Advising Survey
  - It was found that the survey can be modified to fit a more specific need of assessment. Work will continue moving forward on creating one for WSU Advising.
- University Exit Survey
  - Emailed the final copy to the assessment committee for review.
  - Next, the work on a first year survey that includes a look at the student's
    involvement and overall experience. Other surveys to review for student experience
    content include the WSU Housing Survey and BCSSE (Beginning College Survey of
    Student Engagement).
- Today's Meeting
  - Gen Ed Review: It is the charge of this committee to evaluate the gen-ed report that includes English 101, Comm 111, the Library Report and the CLA review.
    - CLA scores
      - Reminder that the CLA testing cohorts are not the same set of students.
         This could skew the data.
      - Is the CLA an assessment that we continue to use?
      - A meeting will be set with the faculty senate president and gen-ed committee chair to discuss what's next for CLA.
  - Student Affairs Assessment
    - Student Involvement: a report has been provided in the Teams folder that demonstrates their work and what activities are being done, demographics of those served and the number of students engaged.
    - Student Affairs Assessment site: work will begin to download the departments' annual reports to the web page.
