## **Update Climate Wide Assessment Project 19-20**

- Climate Study:

- University Graduate Exit Survey: It was noted that 40% of the graduate survey overlapped with the undergrad survey. Included on the survey questions with notes were:
  - 12 a & b: it was proposed to keep the question in the undergrad survey only.
  - 13 & 14: same as undergrad
    - Perhaps use the following sample in the grad survey: "...before registration for classes did you receive appropriate academic advising along with a plan of study?"
  - At the graduate level advisors should be written as the following:
    - o research advisor
    - o program coordinator

- faculty advisor
- o specialty advisor
- #25: Does the question relate to research and or project
- #28-33: It was agreed that these questions will be taken off the survey to be shared with Hanover who will add to their survey.
- The library section was updated by UAC member, Ginger Williams. It was agreed that those questions will remain as provided.
- #51-63 will remain the same with the exception of #58.
- #58 & #64 were discussed as they were similarly written. Therefore, it was proposed that the
  differences/similarity in responses be reviewed with David Wright, as well as looking at the editing the
  verbiage in each question.
