- Updates
 - COVID-19 Response Survey
 - Hanover has the survey and it will be sent out quickly.
 - University Advising Survey
 - Is the Advising Survey shared at AOC (Academic Operations Council)? Yes, it could be and provide an opportunity to be seen by both advisors and deans simultaneously.
 - It was further noted that the survey is discussed in the council of deans and that they are encouraged to discuss the same with deans and advising units.
 - Reminder that the Advising Survey is a compliance issue and required by KBOR. It is not optional.
 - University Exit Survey, Final Review (with David Wright)
 - The number of questions was a concern.
 - There was discussion around adding an additional section for student experience (section 5) to the exit survey.
 - A suggestion was made to add the student affairs questions to the advising survey. It provides more opportunity to update/edit the questions to the students as well as gathering data to either enhance or change services to meet students needs.
 - A set of questions to be considered will be sent via email from student affairs (Alicia Newell) to the committee for review and consideration.
 - Are there additional questions that relate to student services provided outside of student affairs in other areas for data that would look at a broader spectrum of student participation?
 - An inclusive set of student experience questions will be reviewed for addition to the advising survey.
