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Approval of the Minutes

Jim Clark moved to accept the November 15, 2018 minutes. Deepak Gupta, seconded the motion. The committee unanimously supported the motion.

Assessment Committee Discussion

Following the approval of the minutes, the committee began a review of the reports (*as listed above*); the committee looked over the history of the assessments, the student benchmarks and discussed the learning outcomes. There was comment of how the student sample for the CLA assessment is acquired. The response was that an algorithm is created to select up to 1,500 freshman and senior ranked students. Further noted was that the CLA deploys beginning February 1, 2019 will continue through March 2019.

The committee moved forward in looking at the NSSE & FSSE survey. There was discussion of overlapping the faculty & student questions and responses in hopes to find commonly asked questions that would allow for further review of the number of surveys and the types of questions that are being asked in all (i.e., student surveys, academic surveys and office surveys). The greater desire is to look at trends and perhaps centralize the survey questions and then discuss the survey data points during the program review process with program deans and chairs.

Lastly, in the February meeting, the committee will look at survey protocols; Foresight 2020; discuss updates from KBOR and finalize options on sending data reports via email.
