TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID



Scholarships

Scholarships recognize outstanding achievement and/or financial need and do not have to be repaid.

Wichita State Scholarships may be awarded based on your application for admission or be specific to your major or circumstances.

Outside scholarships are awarded to students from external organizations. Don't search - match! wichita.edu/scholarshipuniverse



Work Study

Work study is a need-based opportunity that offers funds for on-campus, part-time jobs to offset educational expenses via hourly paychecks.



Grants

Grants, such as the Federal Pell Grant and the Kansas Comprehensive Grant are based on financial need and do not have to be repaid.



Loans

Student loans require repayment over time. Federal loans offer tax-deductible, fixed interest rates and flexible payment terms. Payments are deferred while you are enrolled at least half time.

Federal Direct Subsidized Loans

Awarded based on financial need and does not gain interest while you are enrolled at least half time.

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans

Awarded regardless of family income and begin to gain interest at a fixed rate once loans are paid to your WSU account.

Parent PLUS Loans

Credit-based loans with fixed interest rates available to parents of dependent students. Parents may request loan repayments be deferred while their student is enrolled. If the loan is denied. WSU will review the student for possible eligibility for independent-level unsubsidized loans.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONS

Tuition Payment Plan

This plan allows you to spread your tuition payments throughout the semester. wichita.edu/ar

Housing Payment Plan

This automatic plan allows you to spread housing payments throughout the semester.

1. APPLY

The Student Aid Account is available at **studentaid.gov** and is used as your electronic signature and log-in for the FAFSA. Your parent(s) will also need one.

Complete the FAFSA form

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available at **studentaid.gov.** WSU's school code is 001950.

2. REVIEW

Review & Update Your FAFSA Submission Summary

If necessary, corrections to the FAFSA can be made at **studentaid.gov**

3. ACCEPT & FINALIZE

 - 1. Log in to myWSU.wichita.edu
 - 2. Click the 'myFinances' tab
 - 3. Click the 'Financial Aid Dashboard' link
 - 4. Select the 'Offer' tab to view your financial aid offer
 - 5. Click drop-down menu to accept/modify/decline loans
 - 6. Submit action and read Terms & Conditions

> Merit & Academic Scholarships

Freshmen Merit Scholarships (GPA & ACT/SAT):

\$1,000 - \$4,000 a year for Kansas residents or students receiving tuition discounts

\$2,500 - \$6,000 a year for non-residents without tuition discounts

Renewable for up to 4 years with 24 earned credit hours & minimum 3.00 GPA

Application priority deadline of December 1

Freshman University Academic Scholarships (GPA-only):

\$1,000 - \$2,000 per year for Kansas residents or students receiving tuition discounts

\$1,500 - \$3,000 per year for for non-residents without tuition discounts

WSU Honors College Merit Scholarships:

\$500 a year for 2 years for incoming freshman and transfer students

Admitted and accepted into the Cohen Honors College by November 1 priority date

WSU National Merit Scholarship Program:

Open to National Merit Finalists

Awards \$20,000 in year 1 and \$10,000 for additional three years

Transfer Merit Scholarships:

\$2,000 - \$3,000 a year for 2 years

Transfer with at least 12 credit hours and maximum of 75 credit hours

Award offers based on minimum transfer GPA of 3.25

Shocker Promise Scholars:

Awards Kansas residents based on financial need
