

Alpha Delta Sigma Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. Scholarship Applicant Criteria, 2019

The men of Alpha Delta Sigma Chapter of Phi Beta Fraternity, Inc. announce two scholarship awards (see below). Applicants may apply for one scholarship. The submission of materials must be postmarked by May 30, 2019. The Chapter will notify award recipients no later than August 1, 2019.

Scholarship Award: \$2,000 (non-renewable)

1. Student male applicant must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 and above. Submit an official high school transcript.
2. Student male applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation. Letters must vouch for student's character, leadership skills, and preparedness to enroll and graduate from the university.
3. Student male applicant must submit a one-page summary of extracurricular activities.
4. Student male applicant must provide an acceptance letter from an accredited four-year college/university.
5. Student male applicant must submit a cover letter.
6. Student male applicant must submit a 3-5-page typed-written persuasive essay. The essay must follow either the writing or formatting guidelines of MLA, APA, or equivalent. Essay specifics provided below.

This essay will be persuasive. Currently, there are more Caucasian first year female teachers, teaching in urban schools. The suspension rate among African American males are much higher than other ethnicities. **This essay must answer this question: should more African American Males consider teaching as a career to help mold and motivate students of color – why or why not?**

Other requirements: (a) provide a proofread essay; (b) please use primary sources like books, newspaper articles, etc. Do not consult Wikipedia. And (c) essay must be free of typographical and grammatical errors.

Scholarship Award: \$1,000 (non-renewable)

1. Student male applicant must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 to 2.99. Submit an official high school transcript.
2. Student male applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation. Letters must vouch for student's character, leadership skills, and preparedness to enroll and graduate from the university.
3. Student male applicant must submit a one-page summary of extracurricular activities.
4. Student male applicant must provide an acceptance letter from an accredited two-year community college or a four-year college/university.
5. Student male applicant must submit a cover letter.
