Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate Freshman Admission
 - minimum GPA 2.5/4.0; or combined SAT 1,060 with min. 490 on part score; or ACT 21 with min. 18 on part score
- Undergraduate Transfer Admission
 - based on 24 credit hours or more
 - Business, Engineering, Fine Arts, Liberal Arts & Sciences majors: minimum CGPA 2.0
 - Education (Applied Studies) majors: minimum CGPA 2.0-2.5
 - Health Professions majors: minimum CGPA 2.75-3.0

 - visit www.wichita.edu/transfergateway for transfer credit details
 - [International Baccalaureate](#) (IB), [Advanced Placement](#) (AP), [Cambridge](#) subjects may receive transfer credit.
- Graduate Admission
 - most programs require a bachelor's degree in related major and a minimum GPA of 3.0 (GRE not required)

English Requirements

- International students are not required to submit a TOEFL or IELTS score when applying for admission.
- Undergraduate applicants** may be granted Conditional Admission if they meet our academic requirements for admission.
- Graduate applicants** are required to submit the score when they are determined admissible.
- Score reports must be sent from the testing authority to Wichita State University (institution code 6884).
- Depending on proficiency level, students who do not meet our English requirement may enroll full time in Wichita State's Intensive English Language Center (IELC) or half-time IELC and half-time degree classes.

- If an undergraduate student wants to attend the optional summer session, an estimate of US\$9,700 shall be added to the above total.
- Actual housing expenditures depend on the residence hall, type of room, and the student's meal plan.

Scholarship & Financial Matters

- Scholarship:** Global Select Scholarship will be automatically awarded to eligible students upon admission. The scholarship will automatically renew until the end of the student's program. Visit www.wichita.edu/GlobalSelect
 - Undergraduate** applicants with GPA of 3.0 or its international equivalent will be awarded US\$20,400 over a 4-year period. Available for both freshman and transfer students.
 - Graduate** applicants with GPA of 3.3 or its international equivalent will be awarded US\$11,600 over a 2-year period. (*Note: MBA students are not qualified.*)
- Tuition Installments:** Paying an administrative fee of US\$30, students may pay the tuition fees in four installments. No interest is charged. Students may apply for the payment plan after arriving in Wichita.
- Working on Campus:** International students may apply for on-campus jobs and work up to 20 hours per week. By working 20 hours per week, students may earn US\$600-\$800 per month. There are over 250 departments and offices on campus that hire student workers.
- Working off Campus:** After attending Wichita State for one year, students may apply through the Cooperative Education Program for off-campus jobs that are related to their major field of study.

Campus Housing

- All residence halls are fully furnished with WiFi, laundry facilities, and restricted access for extra security.
- Dining hall provides both American and international cuisine with Halal and vegetarian options.
- New IELC and undergraduate students under 21 years old are required to live on campus during the first year.
- Transfer students with 24 or more transfer hours may choose to live on campus or off campus.

Campus Facilities

- Free transportation** services of city buses and bicycles are available to WSU students, faculty, and staff.
- The Indoor Sports Facility & YMCA** include swimming pools, basketball courts, volleyball courts, badminton courts, squash courts, fitness studios, indoor track, and more. Outdoor facilities such as tennis courts, track and field, and soccer fields are available as well.
- The Engineering Building** offers top of the line equipment to all students to materialize their ideas. It provides meeting space, machinery workshop, and design studio to students in all disciplines.
- The Innovation Campus** features more than 20 national and international companies such as Airbus, Textron, NetApp, Deloitte, Hyatt Place, etc. It is also home to new classroom spaces and laboratories.

The City of Wichita

- Wichita is the largest city in Kansas and has a metropolitan population of 650,000 people. The city area is 423 km² (size of Chicago is 606 km²).
- Out of the 100 largest U.S. metro areas, Wichita ranks #1 in percentage of jobs involving STEM occupations. Wichita is also the #1 most affordable college city in the U.S.
- The airport (Wichita Dwight D Eisenhower National Airport) is a 15 minutes' drive from campus. Free airport arrival assistance is provided to new international students.
- Wichita enjoys four seasons with 250 days of sunshine a year! The average temperature in Spring (Mar-May) is 20°C, Summer (Jun-Aug) is 32°C, Fall (Sep-Nov) is 21°C, Winter (Dec-Feb) is 7°C.
- Wichita is in the Central Time Zone. During Daylight Saving Time (or Summer Time), which usually starts in March and ends in November, the clocks are set one hour forward.
