*** REQUIRED TASKS ***

Apply to Live On-Campus

According to our records, you have not yet applied to live in one of our residence halls. Wichita State University requires all first-year students under the age of 21 to live on-campus.

Take the English Placement Exam

All students, including American students, are required to take two English Composition classes in order to graduate. Students who do not have an official SAT or ACT score are required to take an English Placement Exam to determine the appropriate English class for you to take. NOTE: The IELTS, TOEFL, and Duolingo exams are not substitutes for the English Placement Exam. Register for the Online English Placement Exam

Take the Math Placement Exam

All students who do not have an official SAT or ACT score, including American students, are required to take the Math Placement Exam to determine the appropriate math class for you to take. Register for the Online Math Placement Exam

Submit Official SAT Results

At the time of your admission, an unofficial SAT score was used to confirm your English proficiency. You must have your official SAT score sent to us directly by the CollegeBoard. Our institution code is 6884. Request Official SAT Scores

Submit a Preregistration Checklist Completion Form

You must complete ALL of the above items **no later than July 15, 2024.** If you do not complete the above items by July 15, you will need to complete them after you arrive in Wichita. To notify us that you have completed all required tasks, please submit a Preregistration Checklist Completion Form.

myWSU and Shocker Email Set Up

Now that you've been admitted, there are two important things you need to do:

1) Set Up Access to myWSU

myWSU is Wichita State University's student portal. It's where you will go to apply to live in a residence hall, enroll in classes, pay tuition, access your Shocker email, and more.

2) Access Your Shocker Email Account

Wichita State has created an email account for you. After you arrive, all correspondence from the university will be sent to your Shocker email account so it's important that you check it every day.

myWSU ID Set Up

Step 1: Go to mywsu.wichita.edu and click on "Manage your password" and then "Forgot/Setup Password."

Step 2: Enter your personal email address and myWSU ID:

Step 3: Click "Email Security Code."

Step 4: Retrieve the security code from your personal email account and paste it into the "Security Code" field. Click "Change Password."

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING

- On-campus housing requirement
 - Under 21 years old
 - Transferring in less than 24 credit hours
- Sign housing contract and schedule move-in date prior to leaving home country
- Contract Move-In: January 11, 2025
- * if you need an earlier date you must prearrange with Housing and Residence Life
- Can not enroll in classes until housing requirement is met

This suite-style residence hall is only open to firstyear students and is located directly next to the




The Flats >>

OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

- For those who do **not** have the mandatory on-campus requirement.

- There is no temporary on-campus housing available for those looking for housing off campus
- Arrange accommodations prior to arrival
 - allow for 7 to 14 business days to find accommodations
- Contact student associations for roommate recommendations



PLACEMENT EXAMS

- Math and English Placement exams are required of all students who do not have
 - official SAT or ACT submitted at the time of admission
 - English or Math transfer credit from a U.S. institution
 - TOEFL, IELTS, and Duolingo can not be substituted for English exam
- These are online exams and should be done prior to leaving your home country. Failure to complete these exams could result in a delay of enrollment
- Can only be taken once
- Math: mix of pre-algebra through Calculus
- · English: writing, reading comprehension, vocabulary, and listening
- Determines course placement
- \$10 per test added to tuition and fee bill



ARRIVAL TO WICHITA

- Earliest date to enter United States: Sunday,
 December 15 Latest date to arrive in Wichita: Tuesday,
 January 14
- Wichita Dwight D. Eisenhower National Airport (ICT)
- Airport Shuttle Service: January 8 through January 15
- Schedule online no less than 48 hours prior to arrival

Thank you for completing the check-in form. The following are the next steps to get enrolled:

STEP 1: Tuberculosis Screening

The State of Kansas requires that all new students be screened for tuberculosis (TB). A hold has been placed on your account that will prohibit your enrollment in classes until you have completed this important requirement. All TB testing appointments must be scheduled in advance before proceeding to Student Health

Services. IMPORTANT: Coverage for WSU's health insurance policy begins on August 1, 2023. Any medical services that you receive prior to this date, including TB testing, will not be covered by insurance.

STEP 2: Placement Exams

All domestic and international students who do not have an official ACT/SAT score or who are not transferring in specific college credits must take the math and English placement exams. These online placement exams allow your academic advisor to know which levels of math and English courses you can be placed in. Please note that the IELTS, TOEFL, and Duolingo exams are not a substitution for the English placement exam. To schedule your exam, please follow the instructions on the link below.

STEP 3: On-Campus Housing Requirement

STEP 4: Advising and Enrollment

After you have completed the above items, you may schedule your advising appointment for enrollment by contacting your advisor.

- Per federal regulations, students on F-1 visas are only allowed to take ONE online class of up to 3 credit
 hours. Please note that this restriction does NOT apply to Hybrid courses.
- · Undergraduate students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours.

STEP 5: Get Your Shocker ID Card

STEP 6: International Undergraduate Orientation

All freshman international undergraduate students are required to attend in-person orientation on Thursday, August 17 and Friday, August 18.

Check-in and refreshments for this event begins at 1:30 pm, in room 233 of the Rhatigan Student Center. The first session will begin at 2:00pm.

- If you do not attend all sessions of the orientation program, a hold will be placed on your account that will
 prevent future enrollment.

STEP 7: Review Health Insurance and Insurance Waiver Information

- · Per Kansas Board of Regents policy, all international students are required to have health insurance.
- · Once you enroll in classes, you will be automatically charged for and enrolled in the student health insurance plan.
- Insurance Waivers: If you already have health insurance coverage from a government agency or other qualifying policy, you will need to complete an insurance waiver. This is particularly important for students covered by SACM or the Kuwaiti government. For more information on health insurance waivers, visit: https://wichita.edu/insurancewaivers. After you check in, you will be sent an email message to your WSU email account from ECI, the company that the State of Kansas uses for insurance waivers. That message will contain important information on how to log in and complete an insurance waiver request. The insurance waiver deadline is: Thursday, August 31, 2023. Failure to complete the waiver by the deadline will result in your automatically being charged for health insurance.

STEP 8: Pay for Your Classes

- . The deadline to pay or set up a payment plan is: Friday, September 1, 2023 fall
- . A late fee of \$100 will be added to your account if you fail to pay or set up a payment plan by the deadline.
