- Washer and dryer in each suite

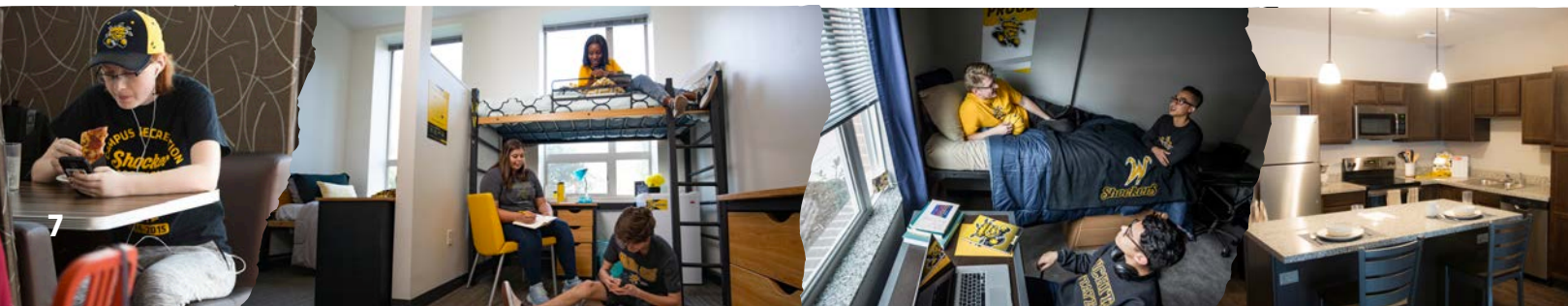
