Please initial each item below.

- _____ I understand any grades I earn while being a high school guest student at WSU will be considered part of my official, permanent college record. I realize that these guest records could be considered relevant as part of my degree-bound admission at WSU or any other institution.
- _____ I understand any college course (at WSU or elsewhere) I take during high school will count towards my cumulative collegiate grade point average and can be considered in the future for admission and scholarship purposes.
- _____ I understand admission as a high school guest does NOT constitute degree-bound admission to WSU.
- _____ I understand I will NOT be allowed to enroll in future guest semesters at WSU unless I maintain BOTH 2.0 cumulative WSU and 3.0 cumulative high school grade point averages.
- _____ I understand I must meet all program requirements and deadlines, and submit all required documents in order to be admitted as a guest.
- _____ I understand regardless of my age or payment responsibility, only I will have access to my academic records at Wichita State University. WSU **will not** share my grades and other records with individuals, including my parents and guardians, without my prior written consent (Section 438 of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974).
- _____ I understand the WSU Schedule of Courses contains information regarding policies and deadlines, including the final withdrawal date for courses (transcript would indicate “W” rather than a letter grade; grade point average would not be affected).
- _____ I understand if I am also taking this class for high school credit my final WSU course grade may be different from my final high school grade according to grading standards set by the WSU academic department.
- _____ I understand, as a high school guest student, I will not be able to enroll unless I am in good financial standing with WSU. **A late fee of \$100 will be assessed for missed or late payments.** All existing bills, including parking and library fines, must be paid before enrollment will be completed.
- _____ I understand, as a **high school guest, I must check my myWSU account regularly throughout the semester of enrollment to verify my course schedule and bill payment records are correct.** Upon admission, I will receive a letter from WSU that includes my myWSU ID number. This information is necessary to access my myWSU account. The ID number and selected password should be safeguarded and not shared with others.
- _____ I understand, as a high school guest student, if I plan to attend a college or university other than WSU after high school graduation, I must contact that institution to determine if WSU courses are accepted in transfer. It is recommended that students contact the department of the major they are considering. Institutions have differing policies regarding how many hours are accepted in transfer and if course equivalencies exist.
- _____ I understand, as an actively enrolled high school guest student, I will have access to numerous on-campus resources, including Ablah Library, LAS Advising Center, Heskett Center and academic support labs such as those for math and English classes.
