- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on 24 credit hours or more
- Applied for admission to WSU*
- * If student does not meet the transfer requirements, they are required to meet freshman requirements as outlined under WSU Admission requirements, https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/undergraduate/qa.php

Cowley College students meeting the above requirements will:

- Be admitted to WSU for the Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management program with completion of WSU application requirements and receipt of transcripts
- Be required to meet WSU General Education Policy or KBOR policy
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 60 credit hours

This agreement is subject to revision or cancellation by either Wichita State or Cowley College if necessary.

2 + 2 Articulation Agreement

Wichita State University Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management and Cowley College Associate in Arts (AA) in Sport Management/Administration

The purpose of this 2 + 2 articulation agreement is to provide Cowley College students the opportunity to transfer coursework from Cowley College to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management (BA – SMGT).

In addition, this articulation agreement identifies requirements, options, equivalencies, and parameters, which will benefit many students for years to come. This document also includes a program of study with a list of equivalent Cowley College and WSU courses by term for the first two years at Cowley; and a list of WSU courses to complete upon transfer to the four-year institution.

Admission/Program/Graduation information

General Education Coursework: The completion and transfer of general education coursework will vary based on the program of study for the specific Cowley College program. General education courses must be at least three (3) credit hours and from the approved general education course list at Wichita State University. Students transferring from Cowley College are required to meet the approved general education program at WSU at the time of transfer. <u>Graduation Requirements:</u> Transfer students must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work and 45 hours of upper division work in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University.

For graduation, students will need to meet all enrollment eligibility requirements at the time of transfer and/or enrollment, fulfill all WSU general education requirements and degree requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by WSU.
