

**2 + 2 Articulation Agreement  
Wichita State University & Dodge City Community College  
for  
Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management**

The purpose of this 2 + 2 agreement is to provide Dodge City Community College students the opportunity to transfer coursework from Dodge City Community College to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management.

The 2 + 2 articulation agreement identifies requirements, options, equivalencies, and parameters, which will benefit many students for years to come. This document also includes a program of study with a list of equivalent Dodge City Community College and WSU courses by term for the first two years at Dodge City Community College, and a list of WSU courses to complete upon transfer to the four-year institution.

**The agreement is for Dodge City Community College students who have:**

- Completed or began an Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree in Sports Administration
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on 24 credit hours or more
- Applied for admission to WSU\*

\* If student does not meet the WSU transfer requirements, they are required to meet freshman requirements as outlined under WSU Admission requirements,

**Dodge City Community College students meeting the above requirements will:**

- Be admitted to WSU for the Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with the completion of WSU application requirements and receipt of transcripts
- Be required to meet WSU General Education Policy or KBOR policy
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 60 credit hours
- Earn 123 credit hours by completing 63 credit hours from Dodge City CC Sports Administration Associate of Arts program and 60 credit hours in the Wichita State Bachelor of Arts Sport Management program. WSU requires a minimum of 120 credit hours, but because of degree requirements at both institutions this agreement will result in 123 credit hours earned.

**Admission/Program/Graduation information**

**General Education Coursework:** The completion and transfer of general education coursework will vary based on the program of study for the specific Dodge City Community College program. General education courses must be at least three (3) credit hours and from the approved

general education course list at Wichita State University  
(<https://www.wichita.edu/academics/generaleducation/>).

Students transferring from Dodge City Community College are required to meet the approved general education program at WSU at the time of transfer. Advisors and students should reference the Wichita State University Transfer Equivalency guide for specific courses – Wichita State Transfer Equivalency or community college transfer guides.

**Admission to WSU:** To apply for admission, students may contact the WSU Admission office by calling: (316) 978-3085. Information and applications are located online at <https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/index.php>.

Students transferring to WSU from Dodge City Community College who have completed an Associate in Arts must meet the necessary requirements for admission to WSU, and will have their transcript evaluated on an individual basis.

**Reverse Transfer:** Based on Reverse Transfer, candidates following the TAP or Elementary Education plan of study at WSU are eligible to utilize this process to complete required credit hours at Dodge City Community College for the attainment of any Associate's degree for which one is eligible (see Reverse transfer @ <https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/undergraduate/transfertowsu>)

**Graduation Requirements:** For graduation, students will need to meet all enrollment eligibility requirements at the time of transfer and/or enrollment, fulfill all WSU general education requirements and degree requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by WSU.

All students, including those transferring from a two-year college, must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work, including 45 hours of upper-division work, in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State.

This agreement is subject to revision or cancellation by either Wichita State or Dodge City Community College if necessary.
